September Biggs Kids Program at the Biggs Museum: Two Sessions of Animation!

Dover, DE – The Biggs Museum is pleased to welcome 2008 DDOA Fellowship Recipient in Media Arts, Paul Hluchan, on Saturday, September 6, to host the September Biggs Kids program. Paul Hluchan will lead this children’s workshop on the basic principles of animation. Children will create animations of objects and drawings for a zoetrope, a 19th century animation device that will be used to explain the optics of animation. Toys will be animated with the stop-motion technique of taking multiple pictures. It is recommended children should bring a toy of their choice to be the “star” of their animation. Biggs Kids Session I will be held 12:30 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. and Session II will be held 2:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. Biggs Kids is a free program for children ages 5-10. The program is open to the public and is held in the program gallery at the Museum. Pre-registration is required.
