# Exciting Additions for 2014 Biggs Gala: An Affair with the Arts Guests Get First Look at "Hanging at the Biggs" Tile Installation

*Dover, DE* (April 30, 2014) –On Saturday, May 10, 2014, the Biggs Museum will host its Annual *Gala: An Affair with the Arts* from 6 p.m. – 11 p.m. A crowd of approximately 350 people will enjoy live entertainment, dinner and cocktails, silent auction, dancing, raffle, and more. Mike Hines and the Look, a local favorite, will be joining the event for the first time. The showmanship and talent of this dynamic group quarantees to yield the right blend of music to have all quests on the dance floor.

## First Installation of "Hanging at the Biggs" Tile Project

The first two panels of the *Hanging at the Biggs* tile project will be installed for the public to view for the first time. These panels consisting of 140 acrylic tiles purchased by the public, will be located in the new sculpture atrium at the entrance of the Museum which was completed during the third phase of capital renovations. These tiles feature a variety of images including everything from artwork, to photographs, to children's artwork, quotations, and more.
