The Ann Marcus collection includes cards decorated with the iconic valentine decorative motifs of flowers, hearts and cupids. These collapsible threedimensional, or "pop-up" cards, became especially popular with the addition of delicate layers of brightly-colored tissue paper and a sculptural quality that was easily mailed. The cards of the Loving Traditions exhibition will be featured within the Museum's new Curator Choice Gallery on the first floor. At the end of the exhibition, Museum guests will find materials to create their own valentine cards in the Museum's interactive art program gallery, Sewell's Studio.
