Important Information

- Camp hours are 9:30 am - 3:30 pm
 - Extended Morning Care is included with tuition and begins at 8:45 am.
 - Extended Afternoon Care is included with tuition and ends at 4:00 pm.
- If your camper has not been picked up by 4:00 pm the police will be called to collect the camper.
- Morning Check in:
 - Each morning please park in the Biggs Museum lot and walk your camper to the check in desk.
 - A hard copy of the Behavior Expectation Agreement must be signed by the camper and caregiver on the first day of camp.
 - We want every camper to have an enjoyable and positive experience at Biggs Summer ArtVenture camp. In order to ensure this we ask that campers:
 - Be able to take care of their own personal needs
 - Have effective group interactions (group projects, discussions, and presentations)
 - Abide by the Behavior Agreement
 - Are not sick and have been fever free without medication and/or stomach illness for 24 hours
 - Museum staff is not allowed to dispense medication, prescribed or over the counter.
- Staff will only provide band-aids and ice-packs.

Lunch and Snacks

The Biggs Museum's Summer ArtVenture Camps are full day programs during which campers will have a 30 minute lunch and a 15 minute snack. Please note: there is no on-site venue to purchase food. Be sure to send your camper with both a healthy lunch and snack.

- No peanut products please
- Please include a water bottle. We will have recess outside (weather permitting).

What to Wear

Campers should come to camp dressed to get messy, create, and innovate. All clothing should be comfortable and able to be managed independently by the camper.

- Each week campers will receive a name tag. We ask that all campers always wear their nametags. For convenience, nametags will be stored at the Biggs Museum so they do not get lost.
- Campers should wear clothes they can get messy – we may be using paints, pastels, markers, inks, and clay. Campers should wear comfortable and closed-toe shoes and be prepared to go outside each day.

What Not to Bring

The Biggs museum does not take responsibility for any broken or missing items brought into the museum. It is strongly suggested that all jackets, hats, and lunchboxes are labeled with the camper's name.

- All electronic devices are strictly prohibited. MP3 players, cell phones, cameras, gaming systems, toys, collectible cards, or pets of any kind are not allowed at the Biggs Museum's Summer ArtVenture Camp. If a cellphone must be brought to camp it will be stored until the end of the day.
- If personal items are brought to camp they may be confiscated by staff and held until they can be returned to the camper's caregiver
